7 Practical tips for educators

TIP #1

Communicate Expectations

Co-create a list of expectations with your students, adding to it as necessary.

TIP #2

Model Responsible Use

Share when and why you have used generative AI with your students.

TIP #3

Clarify that AI is a Tool, Not a Human

Misunderstanding this can lead to misplaced trust or an over-reliance on AI for emotional support or guidance.

TIP #4

Raise Awareness About Bias in AI

Teach students that AI is not the ultimate authority and must be fact-checked for accuracy and bias.

TIP #5

Share How AI Can Be Wrong

Treat AI-generated information as a starting point and conduct further research for verification.

(AI has been known to create false links)

TIP #6

Avoid Sharing PII

Once personally identifiable information (PII) is shared, it becomes part of the information processed by AI models, which can pose privacy risks.

TIP #7

Protect Student Data

It's essential to understand and share (with students/families) the AI tool's terms of use and compliance with regulations in order to protect students.
